Applications are invited from the eligible candidates to fill up the existing vacancies, the vacancies as may occur in future on temporary basis of the following posts:

- (I) **English Stenographers for Civil Courts of Jharkhand** Pay Scale of Rs. 5200-20200/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 2400/- (plus other usual allowance as per rule).
- (II) **English Stenographers for C.B.I. Courts & Family Courts** Pay Scale of Rs. 5200-20200/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 1900/- (plus other usual allowance as per rule).
- (III) **Hindi Stenographers for Civil Courts of Jharkhand** Pay Scale of Rs. 5200-20200/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 2400/- (plus other usual allowance as per rule).( For Hindi Stenographer only, backlog vacancy exists for ST, SC & M.B.C./ E.B.C. Category of candidates, General category candidates need not apply for Hindi Stenographers).

Candidates can submit their application in the prescribed format given below, addressed to the Registrar General, High Court of Jharkhand, Ranchi by Registered post / speed Post only. The last date for receipt of application is 22.02.2014.

## Eligibility criteria

- 1. Candidates must be Graduate from a recognized University having proficiency in English Shorthand and typing for English Stenographers and for Hindi Stenographers, the candidate must be proficient in Hindi shorthand and typing. The speed of shorthand and typing of English stenographers would be 60 and 30 words per minute respectively and for Hindi Stenographer the speed would be 60 and 25 words per minute respectively.
- 2. Candidates must be well acquainted with the computer application and typing on computers.
- 3. The candidates should possess sound health, good moral character and should not be involved in, or related to any criminal case or any case involving moral turpitude.
- 4. The candidates must be above 18 years of age as on the 01.02.14 but not more than the age of 35 years in case of General category, 37 years in case of E.B.C./M.B.C. (Schedule-I) and B.C. (Schedule-II) category, 38 years in case of female (General, E.B.C./M.B.C. and B.C.) and 40 years in case of S.T. and S.C. category candidates. The Physically challenged candidates will get a further age relaxation of five (05) years.
- 5. The reservation policy of the State Government will apply and the benefit of the same shall be given to the candidate belonging to the State of Jharkhand only. The candidates of other states in the reserved category shall be treated as General category candidate.
- 6. The Skill Test of the candidates would be taken first. Only those candidate who will qualify in the Skill test would be called for Personality Test and Interview.
- 7. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the skill test and the Personality Test /Viva voce test.

- 8. Candidates applying for the post of English Stenographer must mention the words "ENGLISH STENOGRAPHER" on the envelope containing the application.
- 9. Candidates applying for the post of Hindi Stenographer must mention the words "HINDI STENOGRAPHER" on the envelope (There is no vacant post for General category candidates for Hindi Stenographers as it is the backlog vacancy which were not fulfilled earlier. Vacant posts are there for all categories of candidates for English Stenographers).
- 10. Candidates desirous of applying for both Hindi & English Stenographer must submit separate applications for Hindi & English Stenographer.
- 11. Candidates must send only one application in an envelope.
- 12. No advance copy would be accepted.
- 13. Applications must be sent through registered post/ speed post only.

- 5. Three recent passport size photographs (including one duly attested by Gazetted Officer), should be affixed in the application form.
- 6. One self addressed unstamped envelope of 10 by 4.5 c.m.
- 7. Attested photocopy of domicile certificate issued by the competent authority, in case of claiming reservation.

# **Important**

- 1. Application should be filled up in ENGLISH in the proforma.
- 2. In the final selection list, those who figure higher in merit list will be appointed against the existing vacancy for the posts of Stenographers in Civil Court. After that, the rest successful candidates will be appointed in the C.B.I. Courts and Family Courts respectively.
- 3. The appointment will be made strictly from the panel of successful candidates prepared on the basis of Merit.
- 4. The name and address of the candidate must be mentioned in the overleaf of the Demand Draft / Postal Order.
- 5. Incomplete applications not conforming to the aforesaid prescribed requirements shall be rejected and no further communication will be entertained this regard.

- 6. The merit list of the candidates for the purpose of appointment shall be prepared on the basis of a test of shorthand and typing followed by personality test and interview.
- 7. The decision of the Selection Committee / High Court for recruitment of all the post shall be final and binding on all concerned and no communication shall be entertained.
- 8. The information regarding schedule of the examination and venue will be announced later on.
- 9. The Admit cards indicating the date of Examination and venue shall be forwarded to the candidates individually by post. If, however, any candidate does not receive the Admit card, he /she may contact the Registrar General of High Court at least two days before the scheduled date of examination.
- 10. Incomplete application not conforming to the aforesaid prescribed requirements shall be rejected and no further communication will be entertained in this regard.
- 11. Canvassing in any form shall result in rejection of the candidature.

Note:- The candidate will have to bring their own typewriter for typing test. No Machine will be provided by the examining authority.
