- 3) a) Certificate of Merit will be issued to top 20 percent or top 40 students, whichever is less, in each category of Quiz.
b) Primary Selection for Posters will be done before final presentation in case the entries are more than 40 in each category. Maximum 40 entries for each category will be accepted for final display. Certificate of Merit will be issued to top 25% or maximum 10 in each category. Scientific papers, design of instruments etc. do not fall under this category.
- 4) At the time of participation student has to bring valid proof of identity.
- 5) Syllabus for Science Quiz: Current science awareness, basic scientific principles, scientific invention and discovery, science and technology interaction, basic mathematics and mathematical reasoning etc. Wrong answer will attract negative marking.
- 6) Theme for Poster Presentation: science and technology interaction, science and environment, science and education, science in media, science and human interaction, science and society, scientific thoughts (cartoons etc.). One should draw some meaningful inference from the poster.
