Essential Qualifications for the posts of Assistant Professor:

1. Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks(or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
2. Besides fulfilling, the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test(NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or Similar test accredited by the UGC.

General Note:-

1.Candidates who are or have been awarded Ph.D degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission(Minimum Standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/Ph.D. degree), Regulations,2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET or similar test.

2.NET conducted by the UGC,CSIR or Similar test accredited by the UGC shall not be required to such Masters Degree Programmes in disciplines for which the said test is not conducted.

3.The candidates applying under PwD category may specifically mention in application their main category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC for the purpose of computing the reservation.

4.The candidates applying under PwD category are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No. 36035/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 29.12.2005.The format is available at the website www.persmin.nic.in

5.The candidates already in service must apply through proper channel.
