1. ONLINE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

- JET-2014 application form is to be submitted online only by following the instructions provided on the web portal. The candidate must fill carefully all the details as required in the online application format
- The duration of submission of online application form will be 07-04-2014 to 26-04-2014.
- Candidate is required to upload his/her recent passport size photograph and signature as per the facility provided on the web portal of the online application form. Ensure that the image size minimum 15 KB and maximum upto 50 KB in the jpg/jpeg/pgpeg/png/bmp/gif file format and the image size minimum 15 KB and maximum upto 50 KB in the jpg/jpeg/pgpeg/png/bmp/gif file format.
- The candidate can edit the details entered by him/her in the application format until he/she clicks the “**Submit**” button for the submission of application form. Once the candidate clicks the “**Submit**” button, he/she will not be able to edit the entered data. **Therefore, the candidates are advised to click “Submit” button only and only if he/she is sure that the data entered in the online application format is correct and no further editing is required.**
- The JET-2014 will not be responsible for any consequences arising out of non acceptance of any correction/addition /deletion of any data of the application form after clicking the final submit button.
- **Deposition of application fees:** The fees for JET-2014 is ₹ 2000/- (excluding bank charges) for General/OBC /SBC candidates and ₹ 1000/- (excluding bank charges) for SC/ST/PH>39% candidates. The candidate after downloading the challan, contact the selected branch of ICICI bank (List displayed on website) and deposit the required fees. This amount is neither refundable nor transferable nor adjustable for future Joint Entrance Test (JET). The bank will generate a transaction ID and issue a receipt of challan in duplicate. Candidates are advised to keep this receipt safely with them for further use.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

A candidate must ensure that he/she is eligible for admission to various courses before filling the JET-2014 application form online. If a non eligible candidate is admitted due to any reason then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled as soon as the mistake is detected even at later stage. Various eligibility criteria for admission to JET-2014 courses shall be as under:

- **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

The candidates who have passed the Senior Secondary (10+2) examination conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan, Ajmer or any other Statutory Board or any examination recognized equivalent to it by Swami Keshwanand Rajasthan Agricultural University, Bikaner and MPUAT, Udaipur in any of the following subjects are eligible to appear in JET :

A candidate must have secured at least 50% marks in the aforesaid examinations (10+2). A relaxation of 5% marks would be allowed to candidate belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non creamy layer)/SBC(Non creamy layer) category.

Candidates who have appeared at any of the aforesaid qualifying examinations (Arts & Commerce stream not eligible) but whose results have not been declared before the commencement of the JET shall provisionally be allowed to appear at the JET.

- **AGE**

The maximum age limit is 25 years as on 26-04-2014. The date of birth as recorded in the Secondary Examination mark sheet/ certificate only will be taken as authentic.

- **DOMICILE CRITERIA/ RESIDENTIAL REQUIREMENT**

The JET-2014 is open to the candidates of Rajasthan domicile only or a candidate must fulfill the following conditions for admission to the various faculties:

The candidate must have studied for the last three years of qualifying examination continuously as a regular candidate in a recognised institution in Rajasthan.

OR

Natural Father/Mother of the candidate has been continuously residing in Rajasthan for a period of last 10 years and the candidate has studied for at least 5 years during this period in a recognised educational institution in Rajasthan.

OR

The candidate must be a bonafide resident of Rajasthan. He/She may be presently studying in any of the states other than Rajasthan.

OR

The candidate is a Son/Daughter of a serving or retired employee of (a) Government of Rajasthan including Officer of All India Services borne on the State Cadre of Rajasthan or (b)Undertaking/Corporation/Improvement Trust/Municipal Bodies duly constituted by the Government of Rajasthan by an act of Law or (c) any of the Universities in Rajasthan or Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan provided that the employee has worked in Rajasthan for three years preceding the last date of submission of the application.

OR

Candidate is a Son/Daughter of a permanent or retired employee of Indian Defence Service and the employee is either of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his/her place of posting or is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of the application for admission provided that in case the defence personnel is of Rajasthan origin, a Certificate has to be submitted by him/her from the employer to the effect that his/her State of origin is Rajasthan at the time of entry in to service.

OR

Candidate is a son/daughter of permanent (serving/retired) employee of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is either of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his/her place of posting or is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of application for admission provided that in case of Para-Military Personnel from the Rajasthan origin, a certificate has to be submitted by him/her from the employer to the effect that his/her State of origin is Rajasthan at the time of entry into service.

OR

Candidate is a son/daughter of a Judge of Rajasthan High Court subject to that he/she submit an undertaking/affidavit stating that such benefit is not claimed or availed by them in any other State.

Note:

- The relevant certificates which are the basis of eligibility of the candidate will have to be furnished by the candidate at the time of registration in the college in original.
- The certificate of bonafide resident of Rajasthan will have to be duly signed by the District Magistrate of the concerned District or officer authorised by him, and must bear the authenticated photograph of the candidate.
- In case of serving personnel, where in service conditions have resulted into eligibility, a certificate of the employer will have to be submitted by the candidate, with appropriate authentication, identification and verification.

3. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- The reservation of seats for various categories will be as per the rules of Government of Rajasthan.
- The caste certificate must bear the photograph of candidate and must be issued by the competent authority.
- In case of OBC/SBC the certificate should not be more than six months old and must clearly indicate non creamy layer
- One seat is reserved in the memory of Late Shri Karan Narendra Singh at Jobner (Founder Quota) in B.Sc. Ag. (Honourous). Candidate admitted on this seat cannot be transferred to other colleges.
- Admission to B.Sc. Home Science (Hons.) at Udaipur is restricted to girl candidates only.
- Number of seats can be increased or decreased at the time of seat allotment

4. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING JET- 2014 ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

The application for JET- 2014 will be accepted online only. The process of online submission of application form for JET- 2014 shall be carried out through SKRAU, website www.raubikaner.org

Date of commencement for filling of the online application : 07.04.2014

Date of closure for filling of online application : 26.04.2014

Fees can be deposited upto 1.00 PM on 26.04.2014 through challan in the selected branch of ICICI Bank.

Candidates must perform the following activities while submitting the online application form:

Step-1 : Documents to be kept ready in hand before filling Online Application Form:

- Scanned image of his/her photograph in jpg/jpeg/pgpeg/png/bmp/gif format (image size minimum 15 KB and maximum upto 50 KB)
- Scanned image of his/her Signature in jpg/jpeg/pgpeg/png/bmp/gif format (image size minimum 15 KB and maximum upto 50 KB)
- Copy of mark sheets of X and XII (if passed already) examination.
- Mobile No. of the candidate or nearest relative.

Step-2: Filling of Online Application Form

- Candidate must read the instructions of filling the application form carefully.
- The entries of online application form must be filled as required.

- Candidate should ensure that the photo and signature are the same as uploaded by the candidate.
- The changes (if required) will be allowed online application form, **before final submission.**
- **Web page will not accept any changes after final submission of online application form.**

Step-3: Taking Print out in Hardcopy only after submission of online application form

- The option for taking the print out of challan form for depositing the required fees will be available just after completion of registration as well as at the 5th step of filling of online application form. The Candidate is required to take out the print of the challan form and deposit the required fees in the selected branch of ICICI bank as notified.
- Printout of filled application form will be generated by the web portal after final submission only.
- Candidate must ensure that the application form no. and challan no. are the same.
- **Candidates need not to send hard copy of application to the university.**

Step-4: Depositing the fees

- Fees of JET 2014 Application form is Rs. 2000/- for General/OBC/SBC candidates and Rs.1000/- for candidates of SC/ST/PH >39%.
- Deposit Rs.2000 or Rs.1000 through challan in ICICI Bank. The bank charges Rs.50/- as processing fees has been added in the challan.
- Candidates are advised to keep bank generated challan in duplicate safely with them for further use.
- Collect copies of challan from bank after deposition of fees in cash and produce the same at the time of under taking JET 2014 as well as at the time of registration.
- Fees can be deposited upto 1.00 PM on 26.04.2014 through challan in the selected branch of ICICI Bank.
- This amount is neither refundable nor transferable nor adjustable for future JET.

5. ADMISSION CARD FOR JET -2014

Admission card for JET-2014 will be uploaded on web portal of SKRAU will be available from 18-5-14 to till commencement of exam. No admission card will be sent personally to the candidate. The Co-ordinator JET-2014 reserves the right to withdraw the permission granted by error to a candidate who is not eligible to appear at the JET-2014 even though the admission card has been issued and produced by the candidate before the centre superintendent of JET-2014.

6. EXAMINATION SCHEME

- In the very nature of competitive examination, no syllabus can be prescribed. However, it is an exercise to pick up the best. There would be a single question paper for all the candidates appearing in JET-2014 for seeking admission in the undergraduate programme in Agriculture, Home Science, Horticulture, Forestry, Fisheries, Dairy Technology, Food Technology and Biotechnology.
- The Question Paper would be available in the following six (06) subjects namely, Agriculture, Biology, Chemistry, Home Science, Mathematics, Physics, however, candidate has to attempt three subjects as opted in application form.
- The candidates desiring admission in Agriculture/ Horticulture/Forestry/Fisheries have to attempt any three subjects except Home science.
- **The female candidates desiring admission in Home Science can attempt any of the three subjects. The female candidate attempting the questions of home science will only be entitled to take admission in Home Science, Udaipur and will not be eligible for admission in other degree programmes.**
- For admission in Dairy Technology and Food Technology, candidates must attempt Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics only.
- Candidates seeking admission to Biotechnology may attempt any three subjects from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology.
- **Candidates attempting the same subject twice or thrice will be disqualified for admission.**
- The question paper will be bilingual and consists of multiple choice type questions (pick up the most suitable answer).
- The question paper will be in the form of a test booklet containing different subjects viz Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Agriculture and Home Science, each having 40 questions. There would be four suggested option [(1), (2), (3), (4)] to each question.
- The candidates are required to choose the most appropriate option and blacken the corresponding circle with the black/blue ball point pen in the OMR sheet (Details for filling answer sheet are given on side 1st of sample answer sheet). The test booklet may be used

by the students for rough work and the squares printed in it may be used for deciding the correct answer. Assessment will be made only on the basis of marking on the OMR sheet.

- **There will be negative marking.** Three marks will be awarded for every correct answer and one mark will be deducted for every wrong answer. If more than one option is chosen, it will be treated as wrong answer. No marks will be allotted or deducted for questions unmarked/unattempted.
- The merit list will be prepared on the basis of the percentile marks obtained by the candidates, either appearing in one/more than one programme.

7. SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATION

JET-2014 will be conducted on 25th May, 2014 (Sunday) from 9.00 to 11:00 AM. The schedule of the test will be:

Candidate should report to the examination centre	08:30 AM

No candidate will be permitted after	09:30 AM
Candidate will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before	11:00 AM

8. OPTION FORM

All candidates applying for JET will have to appear at the examination to be conducted by the Swami Keshwanand Rajasthan Agricultural University, Bikaner on the date and time mentioned on the website. The option forms will be invited from all the candidates who appeared in JET – 2014.

To fill up the option form logon to website www.raubikaner.org Click on JET, then option form. Enter your application number along with the password generated at the time of registration. Fill up the options in the order of your choice. Fill No 1 against the college and degree which you prefer first, thereafter second and subsequently as much as you want, but fill up only those options where you really want admission. No column in the option form should be left blank. Candidate should put the cross mark against the colleges where they do not want to take admission. . Options given by the candidate are final. No further editing will be allowed.

SEAT ALLOTMENT

Candidates eligible for admission shall be allotted seats as per their category and sub category through Option Form based on merit and order of option given by the candidate. Candidates securing equal marks in JET will be admitted in the following order of preference:

- (i) One who has secured more marks in Senior Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination.
- (ii) Among candidates securing equal number of marks in (10+2) or its equivalent examination, those who have passed in lesser number of attempts will be given preference. If there is a further tie, candidates securing more marks in Secondary Examination or the equivalent examination will be given preference.

Reservation: Reservation to category [SC(16%),ST(12%),OBC(21% for non creamy layer),SBC(1% for non creamy layer)] and sub categories [Female(25%),PH(3% for disability more than 39%), Defence (3%)] will be provided as per existing rules considering it college level. In case of wards and widows of defence personnel the eligible candidate shall be admitted as per following priorities-cum-merit:

Priority-I : Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel killed in action (Category I).

Priority-II : Wards of serving personnel and ex-serviceman disabled in action (Category II).

Priority-III : Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel who died in peace time with death attributable to military service (Category III).

Priority-IV : Wards of Defence Personnel disabled in peace time with disability attributable to military service (Category IV).

Priority-V : Wards of ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards like Param Vir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Sarvottam Yuddh Seva Medal, Maha Vir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Uttam Yuddh Seva Medal, Vir Chakra, Shaurya Chakra, Yuddh Seva Medal, Sena, Nausena, Vayusena Medal and Mentionin-despatches (Category V).

Priority-VI : Wards of ex-servicemen (Category VI).

Priority-VII : Wards of serving personnel (Category VII).

After first allotment and reporting of candidates in the respective Colleges within stipulated date, vacant seats of different categories will be filled by upward assessment and spot admission if required for other candidates in order of merit in accordance with admission policy College Education, Government of Rajasthan.

UPWARD ASSESSMENT (Transfer/change of College/degree of higher choice)

The admitted candidates reported in the college are only eligible. The upward assessment will be made on the basis of Option Form already submitted by the candidate. No new option will be allowed. They should submit application to the Head of the Institution for upward assessment along with fees of Rs. 500/- (This fees is transferable to Controller of Examinations). Only those candidates will be considered for upward assessment whose name and fees reach the Co-ordinator on or before the stipulated date and time. After new allotment they will loose their claim on the previous seat. Thereafter, no request for change will be entertained and *status quo is maintained*.

Candidates who fail to report in respective college on the stipulated date will not claimed for further admission.

All the original documents of candidates have to be thoroughly checked as well as tallied with the information provided by the Co-ordinator to the Principal/Dean of respective College. False/Suppression of information/certificate will be liable for cancellation of admission and the fees will be forfeited.

All candidates provisionally admitted will be examined by the Medical Board appointed by the Dean/Principal of concerned College regarding their general and physical fitness. The candidates found unsuitable will be rejected. The decision of the Board in this respect will be final.

IMPORTANT

All information related to the JET-2014 will be available on University website www.raubikaner.org

- The Online application shall not be entertained in any case after **26th April, 2014**.
- The candidates applying for admission to more than one programme shall submit only one application form.
- Candidate awarded supplementary in qualifying examination, even if securing merit of JET, will not be considered for admission.
- If information/documents are found false at any stage, admission will be cancelled with immediate effect and total fees will be forfeited.
- The JET-2014 shall be held on **Sunday, 25th May, 2014** from 9.00 AM to 11.00 AM at the centres specified by the University at Ajmer, Bikaner, Jaipur, Jobner, Kota, Udaipur, Sriganganagar, Jodhpur and Bharatpur.
 - The Co-ordinator has the right to the change the centre of examination.

If candidate fails to report in allotted college by the stipulated time/ left the college then his/her seat will be allotted to another candidate and total fees will be forfeited. He/she is also not eligible for upward assessment.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE CANDIDATES

1. The examination will be held as per the programme given. The doors will be opened at 8.30 A.M.
2. A seat marked with Roll Number will be allotted to each candidate. The candidate should ensure that he/she occupies the allotted seat only. Any candidate occupying the seat of another candidate shall be turned out from the examination and also have to accept any other penalty imposed on him/her by the Centre Superintendent.
3. Candidates should bring the following at the time of examination.
 - i. The admit card downloaded from the university website.
 - ii. A passport size photograph pasted on a paper and duly attested by a Gazetted officer/Principal of school. The photograph should be the same as uploaded by the candidates while filling application form online.
 - iii. The copy of challan form showing the details of deposition of fees.
 - iv. Blue/Black ball point pen for marking the answers.
4. They must not bring any text-book or notes, log tables, calculators, cell phone, purse/bag and any other objectionable material with them to the examination hall.
5. Candidates should carefully read the instructions and the questions given in the question paper booklet before they begin to mark their answers.
6. The question paper will be in English as well as in Hindi. However, in case of discrepancies only English version will be treated as correct.
7. No second question booklet/ OMR sheet shall be issued to candidate under any circumstances.
8. Soon after the question booklet is given to the candidate, he/she should ensure that it contains all the pages and no question is missing.
9. Before attempting the answers, the candidate shall write his/her Roll number and other details at the place provided for the purpose on the test booklet and answer sheet. The candidate should indicate the answer by blackening the circle with **blue/black ball point pen** provided for the purpose in the answer sheet itself, otherwise his/her answer will not be evaluated.
10. The candidate should not write his/her name or mark any sign/mark on any place on the answer sheet, which may disclose his/her identity. Non-compliance of this rule shall be punishable as per rules for unfair-means.

11. No candidate shall leave his/her seat or the examination hall till the end of the examination without the permission of the Invigilator /Superintendent of the Centre.
12. During the course of examination, the candidate shall be under the discipline and control of the Centre Superintendent and shall abide by the instructions issued during the examination by the invigilators or the Centre Superintendent from time to time.
13. Candidate found acting in a manner, which in the opinion of the invigilator, is liable to give unfair advantage to another candidate, shall be forthwith suspended from the examination by the Centre Superintendent.
14. The invigilators, the Flying squad and the Centre Superintendent shall be competent to take search of any candidate. A candidate possessing objectionable material or resisting search shall be punishable as per rules of unfairmeans.
15. Candidate resorting to use of unfair-means shall be turned out of the examination hall/room and the examination shall be treated as cancelled. The Centre Superintendent shall be the judge to determine whether unfair-means have been resorted to. He/she will submit the report stating full facts of the case of unfair-means to the Co-ordinator for further necessary action.
16. Urinals for use of examinees shall be provided at the Centre and every examinee shall be required to use one of those urinals only. For this the candidate shall not leave the examination room without the permission of the invigilator and escort.
17. Smoking and consumption of other intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the examination hall/room/centre.
18. No guarantee is given to the candidates regarding the order of the question papers.
19. The result of the test will be declared on specified date. No. enquiries by telegram, telephone or post concerning the result will be attended by the Office of the Coordinator.
20. Candidate should note carefully that there will be no re-evaluation of the test answer-sheet.
21. All original documents are to be submitted only at the time of registration at the allotted colleges.
