I INTRODUCTION

The Existing Syllabus of Kerala Government Certificate Examination in Fine Arts was implemented vide Government Orders read as 1st above from the academic year 1992 onwards. As per reference 4th Government has also pleased to rename it as Kerala Government Certificate Examination in Fine Arts and Animation. The responsibility for conducting the examination is handover to the Controller of Technical Examinations. As per 5th paper, Government has notified that two more chances will be given to appear for the Examination, to those who had written the Examination in previous years and failed. The last examination in the Old Scheme will be conducted by the Pareekshabhavan during June 2014.

II ELIGIBILITY

Registration for the Examination is restricted only to those who had written the examination but failed in any subject.

III SCHEME OF STUDY

1. A candidate passing all subjects in first chance securing an aggregate of 60% marks and above will be declared to have passed the examination in the first class.
2. A candidate passing all subjects in the first chance securing an aggregate 50% marks and above but below 60% will be declared to have passed the examination in the second class.
3. All other candidates who secure 40% and above but below 50% will be declared to have passed the examination in third class.

4. A candidate will not be allowed to appear the examination for more than 4 chances.
5. There will be no supplementary examinations. Only one examination will be conducted in an academic year.
6. **There will not be any revaluation for this examination. Application for Scrutiny of Answer paper can be submitted within 15 days from the date of receipt of Mark list at the Centre. Scrutiny is applicable to Theory Paper only (Paper I).**

IV INSTRUCTIONS

The Head of Institutions will collect all such applications and send the same through the examination centre concerned along with Chalan receipt of fee collected (Specified in Para 6) to the Secretary to the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Pareeksha Bhavan, Poojappura, Thiruvananthapuram – 12 within the prescribed time limit. Copy of order granting recognition to the institution should also be enclosed without fail. Name of Examination centers are given as ANNEXURE – A.

V. PREPARATION OF A LIST, APPLICATION etc.

A specimen application is enclosed as Appendix – I. Identification Certificate and admission ticket are also enclosed as Appendix II and III respectively. Application form have to be get filled up from the candidates along with the identification certificate and Hall tickets. Two passport size photographs of the candidate should be obtained and one should be pasted in the identification certificate and the other one in the hall ticket. Both photograph should properly be identified by either Gazetted Officer or by the Head of the Institution. True copy of the General Qualification Certificate, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or by the Head of the High School or Training School should be enclosed along with the application and other documents. After preparing 'A' list, the following declaration should be furnished at the bottom of list by the Head of the institutions with proper authentication "Certified that the above candidate have prescribed minimum qualification and that they have completed the prescribed course of study".

VI EXAMINATION FEE

Government, as per G.O 2nd cited have revised the rate of examination fee as shown below.

Fee for full course	Rs. 400/-
Fee for one paper	Rs. 150/-
Fee for Scrutiny per paper	Rs. 50/-

The Head of Institution should collect the examination fee as noted above and **fee for mark list Rs. 40/-** from each candidate and remit the same into the Treasury in the prescribed time as per the programme shown below. Examination fee and fee for mark list should be remitted in the respective Head of Account. Both Chalan receipts should be forwarded along with other documents.

All the candidates except students belonging to SC/ST, Kudumbies and X'ian converts from among them, should remit examination fees. Students who are exempted from payment of fees are eligible to appear for only two chances, provided that the second chance should be within a period of 3 years from the first appearance. In the case of fees exempted categories, the Head of Institutions should furnish a certificate to the effect that this is the First/Second appearance of the candidate, in their application.

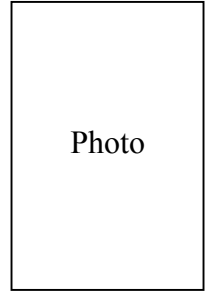

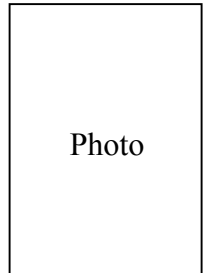
