1. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

Vidya Academy of Science & Technology Technical Campus (VAK), Kilimanoor is the second engineering college of Vidya International Charitable Trust (VICT), an NRI venture functioning in the higher educational field of Kerala State since 2001. VICT is backed by more than 1000 trustees, all NRIs. VICT started its first Engineering college, Vidya Academy of Science & Technology (VAST) Thalakottukkara in Thrissur District in the year 2003. From a humble start with 240 students in four branches of engineering in 2003, the college has grown to a centre of excellence with an intake of 630 students for B Tech, 60 for MCA and 96 for M Tech each year.

Our Thrissur College (VAST) has become a trend setter in professional education in the state by providing maximum opportunities to its students to avail scholarships through "VAST Scholarship Programme". This scheme was introduced in 2003, the very first year of functioning of Thrissur College. Scholarships are provided to more than 650 meritorious students till date. VAST also offers generous endowments to the University toppers and other assistance to the needy students in moments of crisis by the help of trustees and well wishers.

VAST has performed well in University examinations from the first batch onwards. Pass percentage hovers around 90% in individual exams and 75% in overall pass percentage. It has got excellent infrastructure and high quality faculty. The High Power Committee appointed by Director of Technical Education as directed by the Hon. High court has ranked engineering colleges in the state. VAST is ranked in 11th position among 82 colleges surpassing many colleges under Government owned and aided sector. We are 2nd among the most sought after colleges in the self financing sector and 4th among all colleges under the University of Calicut, based on the recent update published by the University.

After stabilizing the first college at Thrissur, armed with 10 years experience of successful running of a professional college, VICT expanded its operations to the southern Kerala by starting VIDYA ACADEMY OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY TECHNICAL CAMPUS (VAST TC) at Malakkal, off MC Road from Thattathumala in Kilimanoor Village, Thiruvananthapuram Dist. The College started functioning in 2013 and has completed one year



of successful journey. All infrastructural facilities are being arranged ensuring compliance to university and AICTE requirements and to accommodate the future needs to build up academic excellence. 3. <u>DURATION OF COURSES</u>

- a. B.Tech degree course will be completed over a period of 4 years consisting of 8 semesters.
- b. B.Tech (LET) course will be completed over a period of 3 years consisting of 6 semesters.

4. <u>ELIGIBLITY FOR ADMISSION</u>

a) <u>B.TECH</u>

- Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Mathematics separately, and 50 % marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together are eligible for admission.
- Candidates should have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 60% aggregate marks in Physics & Chemistry put together and 45% marks in Mathematics are also eligible for admission.
- Candidates who have diploma in Engineering awarded by the Board of Technical Examinations, or an examination recognized equivalent thereto, by the State Board of Technical Education after undergoing an institutional course of at least 3 years, securing a minimum of 50% marks in the final Diploma Examination are eligible for admission to the special reservation quota.



• Candidates should have passed and be ranked in the Kerala Engineering Agriculture Medical Entrance exam (KEAM) 2014.

b) **<u>B.TECH (LET)</u>**

- Candidates who have passed Diploma in Engineering awarded by the State Board of Technical Education or equivalent after undergoing regular course of three years of study in an approved institution are eligible for admission.
- Rank in Entrance exam 2014 for Lateral Entry Test (LET)

5. <u>RELAXATION IN MARKS</u>

B.TECH

Candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC)/ Persons with Disabilities (PD) category with a total annual family income not exceeding Rs.6 lakhs, are eligible for relaxation in the qualifying examination. They need to score only 40% marks in Mathematics and 55% aggregate marks in optional subjects- Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) put together. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates need to score only pass marks in the qualifying examination.

6. <u>ELIGIBLITY FOR NRI SEATS</u>

Eligibility remains the same as above except that NRI candidates are exempted from appearing in KEAM – 2014. However for VIDYA institutions minimum qualifying marks for NRI will be 60% and 55 % respectively for general and reservation categories.

7. HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO MANAGEMENT SEATS

 a) Application forms will be issued from 16 April 2014 onwards. Application can also be made online through the college website www.vidyatcklmr.ac.in on remittance of Rs 500/- by D.D in favour of Vidya Academy of Science & Technology Technical Campus payable at Kilimanoor



b) Duly filled application shall be submitted to the college online, by hand or by post before the last date notified.

8. <u>ALLOTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SEATS AND ADMISSION</u>

a) **B.TECH**

- All applications received up to the last date notified shall be considered for allotment of seats.
- Candidates will be ranked based on their KEAM 2014 marks / ranking and the Vidya rank list will be declared and posted on the website, notice boards etc by 11 June 2014.
- Students and parents are advised to visit college web site regularly after publication of rank lists for daily status of vacancy position and counseling dates. Counseling for seat allotment and admission will commence in the college from 12 June 2014. Parents /Guardian should accompany the candidates appearing for counseling.
- All original documents and complete fees for the first year are to be deposited by the candidates at the time of admission.

b) **B.TECH (LET)**

• Allotment of management seats will be on the same lines followed for B.Tech. Notification will be given separately in case separate instructions are received from Director of Technical Education.

• General

Vidya Academy of Science & Technology Technical Campus (VAST TC) is located at Malakkal, off MC Road from Thattathumala in Kilimanoor Village, Thiruvananthapuram District. It has got excellent infrastructure covering about 17831 m² built up area with modern computer centre, state-of-the art laboratories, broadband internet connectivity, well stocked library and E-journal facility, language lab and other amenities namely fleet of buses for transportation, modern medical centre and counseling cell handled by qualified psychologist. Caution against Ragging

• Attendance

• Examinations

Curriculum followed shall be as prescribed by the University of Kerala.

• Staff

The college has total staff strength of 65 including 32 teaching staff. All faculty members are with post-graduate and doctorate qualifications.

• Uniform

The college shall have a prescribed uniform for the students.

• Training & Placement

Emphasis will be given to training and placement requirements of the students. Specific training programmes under the guidance of Placement officer shall be rolled out to enhance the capabilities of the students and to meet the expectations of the industry. Over the years, students from our existing college at Thrissur have secured placement offers from leading IT, Non-IT and public sector companies. The college at Thrissur is accredited by Tata Consultancy Services for placement activities and has tie up with Infosys Limited through their Campus Connect programme.
