## Welcome to the Online Registration Form Help

Follow the steps detailed in this user guide to fill and submit the online application

There are **3 STEPS** to apply for the **MHADA lottery 2014**.

**A. REGISTRATION :** A new applicant who desires to fill up an application for MHADA Lottery 2014, will have to register himself first. The basic information like, Name, Mobile Number, PAN Card number, Passport Size Photograph, Bank Account Number for refund etc is collected and Registration is done.

**B. ONLINE APPLICATION :** A registered applicant can fill the online application form by giving further information about the Income Category, Reservation Category etc. The applicant can see the details of the Schemes available for the lottery and choose them. The applicant fills up the form for a particular scheme. For every scheme applied, there will be a separate application form filled up.

**C. PAYMENT :** The two options given for paying the EMD are, Payment through Demand Draft (DD) and Online Payment through Debit, Credit Cards and Internet Banking. In cases where the applicant chooses to pay through DD, the completed application form has to be printed and submitted to the nearest branch of Axis Bank (listed in the advertisement) along with the Demand Draft. The applicants paying EMD through Online Payment method, will have to submit the application form online and keep a copy of it with him.

### IMPORTANT:

1. Please read the information booklet available on the lottery website of MHADA <https://lottery.mhada.gov.in> carefully before starting to fill the application form.
- 2..Plz make sure that your monthly income is properly calculated as per the definition of monthly income of the family given in the information booklet. The monthly income of the applicant will determine his/her income category.
3. Please make sure that as far as possible, submit the mobile number which is available with you, as future communications will be done on SMS also.

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4. Please make sure that you give your email address at the time of registration. All the communications are also sent on the email ID of the applicant.
5. UID of the applicant is also required. It is mandatory to give UID at the time of possession.
6. It is mandatory to fill all the details in the fields marked “\*” in the online application
7. Applicants paying EMD through Online Payment, do not have to submit the Acknowledgement receipt at the Bank

  - vii) Draw of Lottery : 10.00 AM 31<sup>st</sup> May 2014
  - viii) Publication of Result of Lottery : 6.00 pm 31<sup>st</sup> May 2014

1. Applicants to click on the link mentioned as ‘APPLY NOW’ and carefully fill the online application form.
2. It is mandatory to fill all the details of “\*” marked fields in the online application.
3. To ease online application process, keep the following information handy.
4. The average monthly income of applicant and their family members, if earning, during specified period in the application form.
5. The applicants’ soft copy of photo with size (min 5kb and max 50 kb).
6. P.A.N. number of applicant (PAN No.).
7. Date of birth of the applicant, UID Number [Aadhar Card].
8. The applicants present residential address with postal code.
9. Mobile number, residence telephone number, office telephone number, and if applicable email address of the applicant.
10. Details of the applicant’s bank information, viz. account number and bank’s MICR code or bank’s IFSC code.
11. After filling in the application carefully, click on ‘**SUBMIT**’. Check the details that were specified while filling up the form. If the details are correct, click on ‘**CONFIRM**’ to confirm the application details.

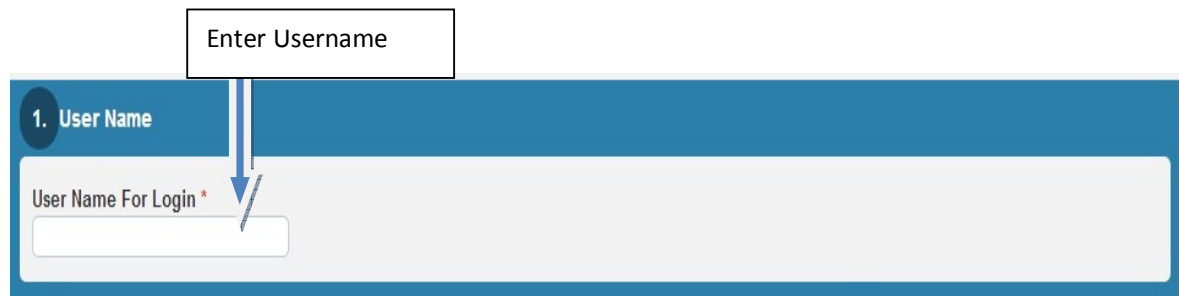

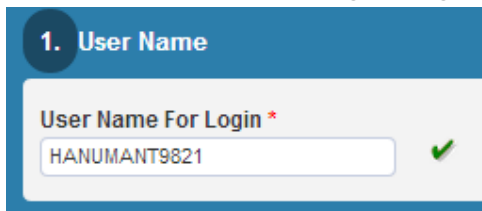

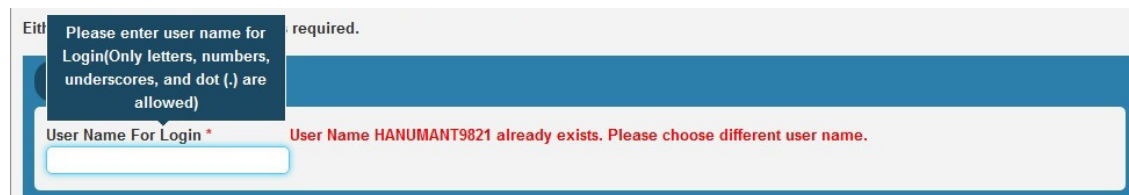

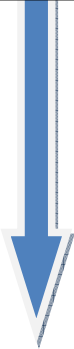

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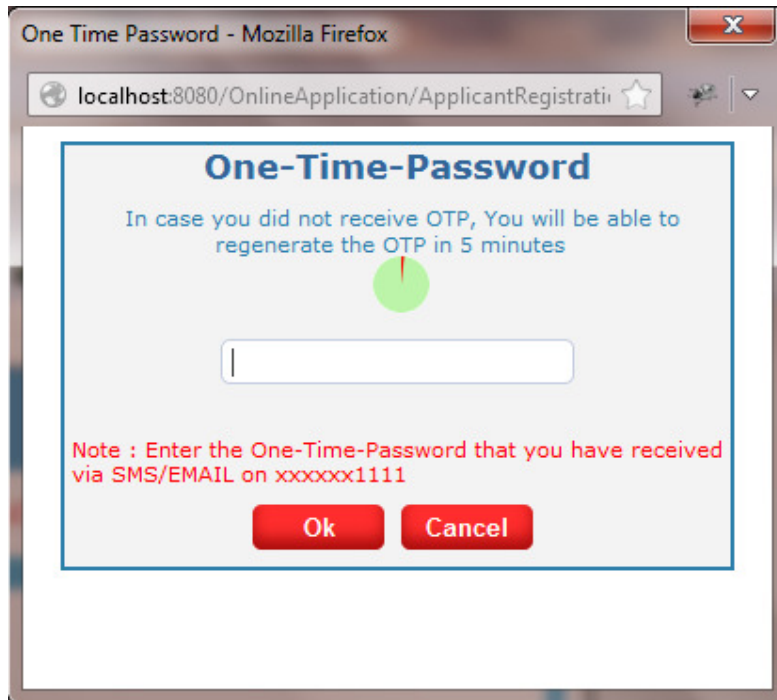


Figure 6: One-Time Password

### Step8. Applicant Photo

The applicant has to upload his/her recent photo. The following points about the photo should be taken care of.

1. The soft copy of photo should be JPEG format i.e. Joint Photographic Experts Group.
2. The size of photo should be less than 50kb.
3. The photograph should be passport size and should be clearly showing the face of the applicant with sufficient light on the face. The background of the photograph should be as light as possible.

4. Then click on the OK button.

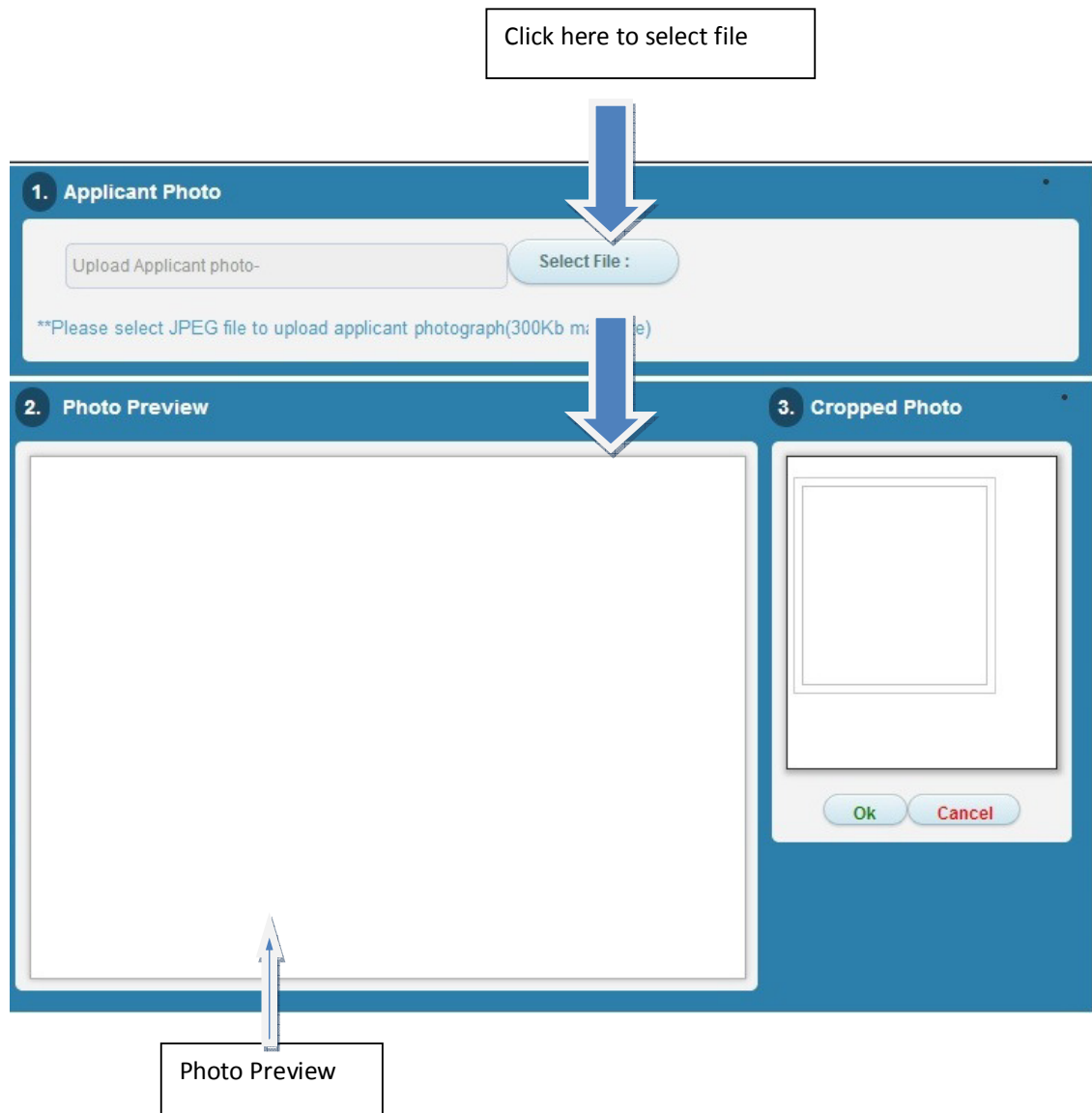


Figure 9: Uploading Photo

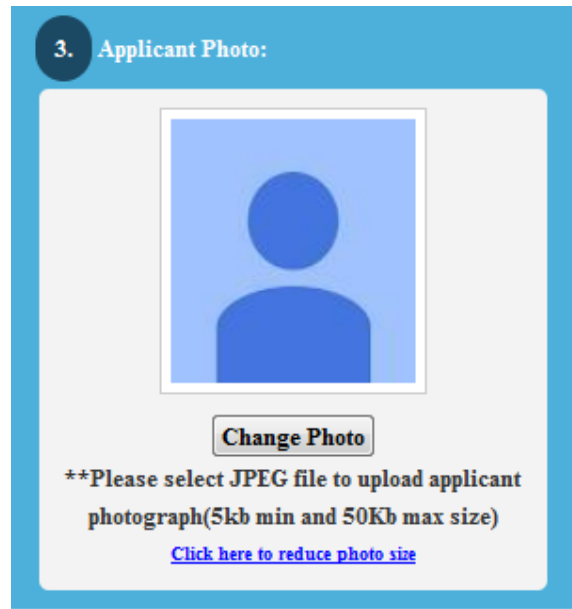


Figure 10: After Uploading Photo

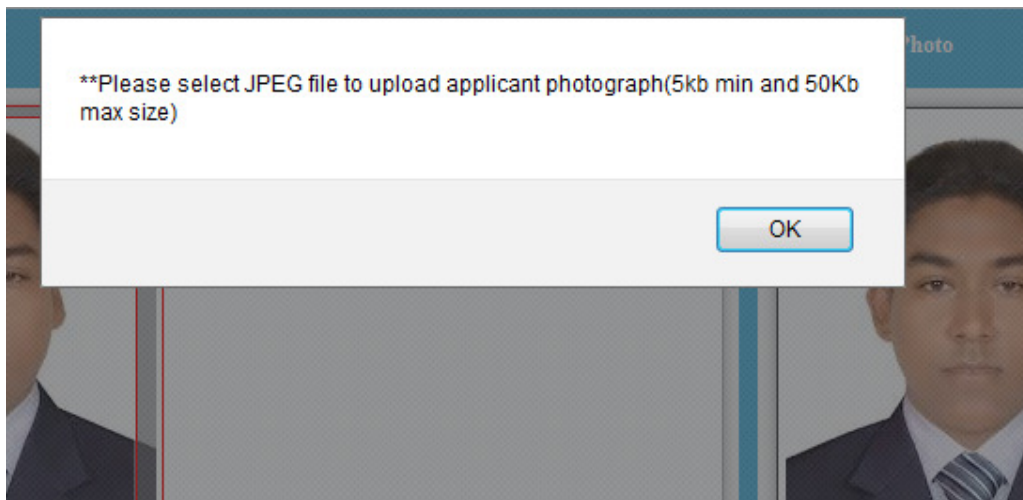


Figure 11: Error Message

### Step9. PanCard Details

The applicant has to enter his PANCARD number i.e. Permanent Account Number.

1. The Pocard number should be 10 digit i.e. first 5 numbers are alphabet [A-Z], next 4 numbers are digits [0-9] and last one is alphabet.  
Example: JAINS9876A
2. After entering the PAN Card number, the PAN Card details will be checked online by the system and the name as in the PAN Card will be displayed automatically in the space given below.
3. In case the PAN Card entered is already entered by somebody else, then a message will be displayed to scan and upload the copy of PAN Card . The uploaded copy will be scrutinized by MHADA officers online and a decision will be taken.
4. In case the entered PAN Card is not verified online or is not existing in the PAN database, you will have to upload the scanned copy of the PAN Card which will be verified by the MHADA officials.
5. After verification by the MHADA officers, the Clearance will be given which will be displayed at the top against the PAN Card. Please refer fig below

## Step13. Details of Bank Account of Applicant

The applicant has to enter following bank account details:

1. The applicant has to enter bank account number in 8.1 and 8.1(A).
  2. The applicant has to enter IFSC i.e. Indian Financial System Code.
- OR**
3. The applicant has to enter MICR i.e. Magnetic Ink Character Recognition.
  4. After entering the Bank Account number and either MICR or IFSC code , the Bank Account details will be checked for uniqueness by the system



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5. In case the Bank Account number with either MICR or IFSC code is already entered by somebody else, then a message will be displayed to scan and upload the copy of Cancelled Cheque . The uploaded copy will be scrutinized by MHADA officers online and a decision will be taken.
6. After verification by the MHADA officers, the Clearance will be given which will be displayed at the top against the Bank Account Details. Please refer below fig

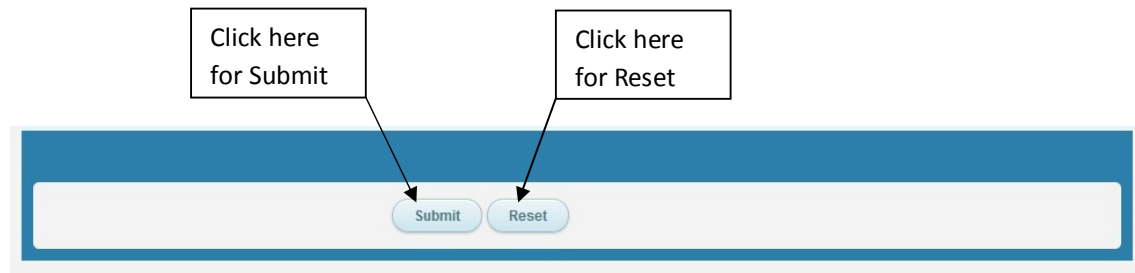


Figure 21: Submit or Reset

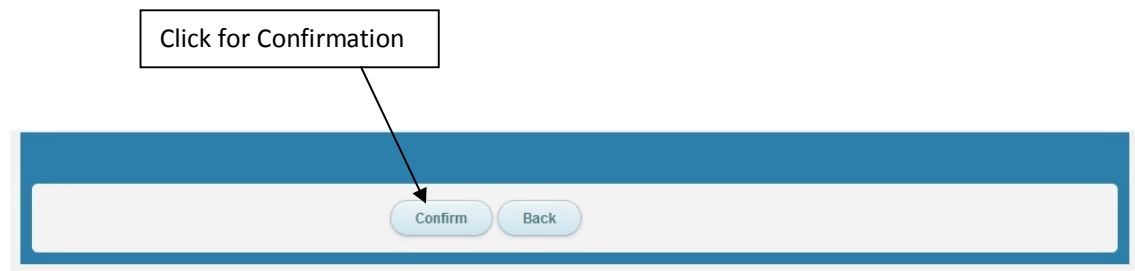
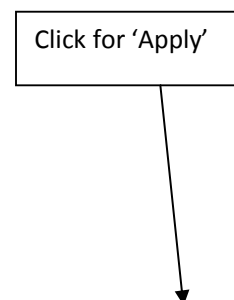


Figure 22: Confirmation

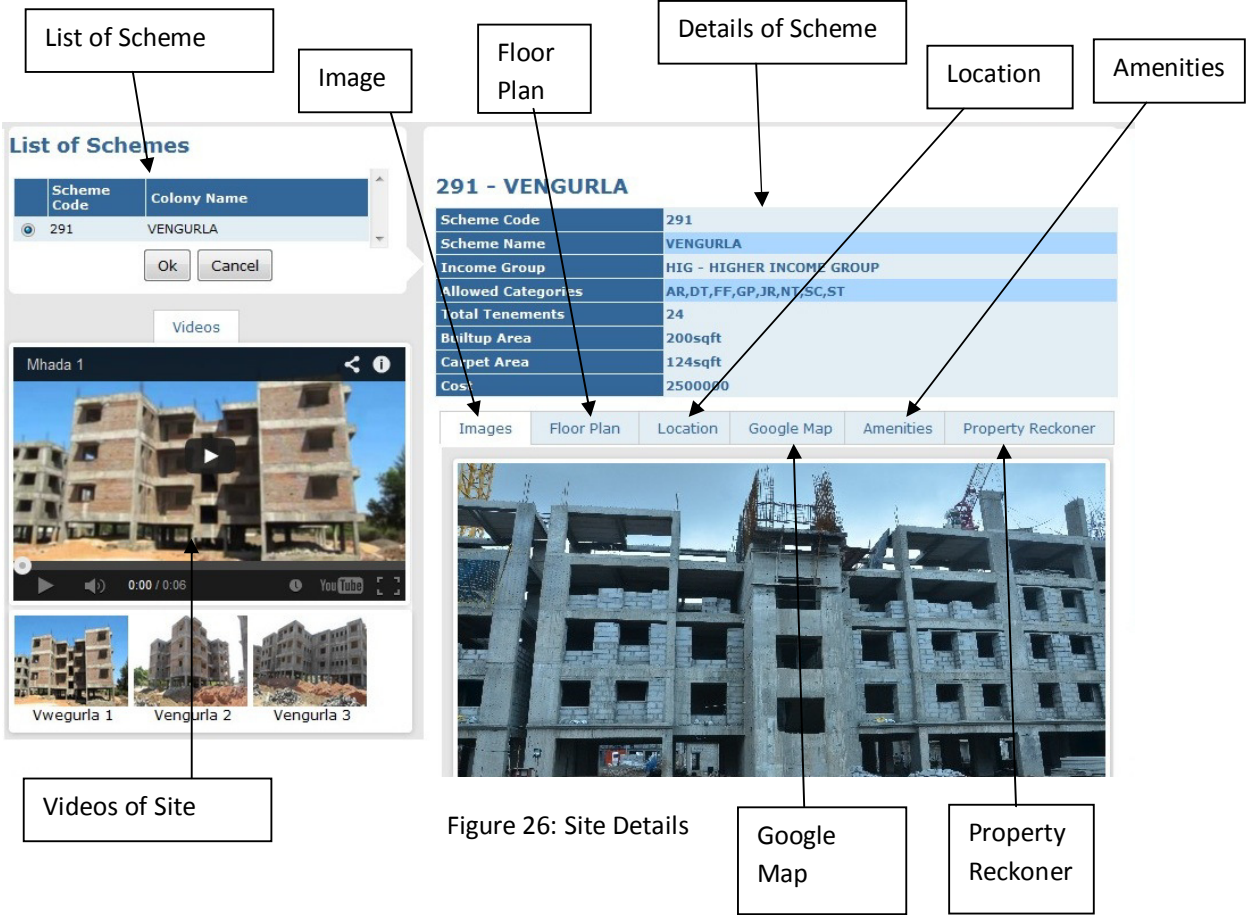


Figure 26: Site Details

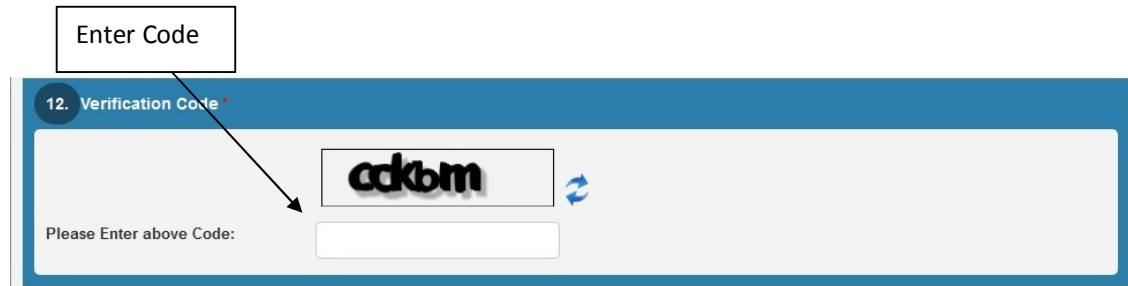

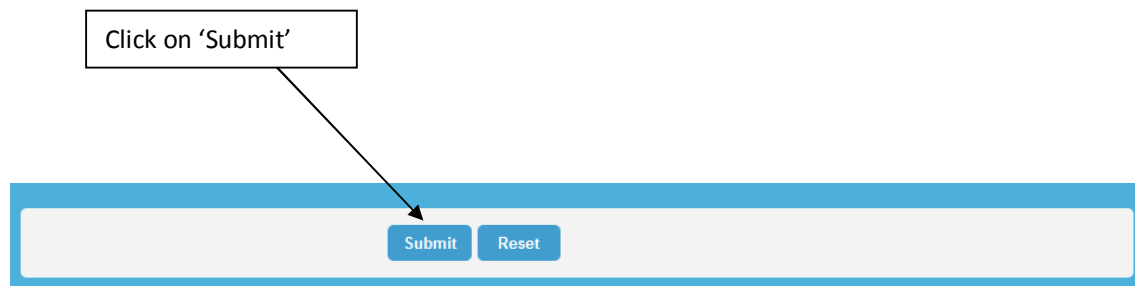

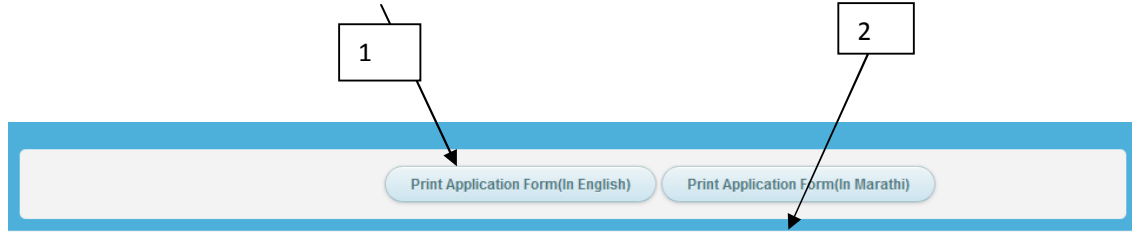
Figure 34: Submit
