1. Professor (2 Posts) – 2 UR: Pay Band: Rs. 37400-67000/-, Academic Grade Pay Rs. 10000/-

Essential Qualifications:

- i) An eminent scholar with consistently good academic records with Ph.D. qualification in any branch of law and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and / or research / policy papers.
- ii) A minimum 10 years of teaching experience in university/law college, and/ or experience in research at the University/ National Level institutions/ industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology 6 mediated teaching learning process.
- iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC Regulation.

OR

An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field who has made significant contribution to knowledge of law to be substantiated by credentials.

Desirable: Research papers published in referred International and National Journals.

2. Associate Professor (2 Posts) - 2 UR: Pay Band Rs. 37400-67000/-, Academic Grade Pay Rs. 9000/-

Essential Qualifications:

- (i) Consistently good academic record with a Ph.D. degree in any branch of law.
- (ii) 55% of the marks, or equivalent grade wherever grading system is followed in the LL.M.
- (iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic / research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/ College or Accredited Research Institution/ industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and / or research / policy papers.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology ó mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC Regulation.

3. Assistant Professor (5 posts) - 3 UR, 1 ST, 1 OBC: Pay Band Rs. 15600-39100/-, Academic Grade Pay Rs. 6000/-

Essential Qualifications:

Consistently good academic record with at least 55% of the marks or equivalent grade where grading system is practiced at the Masterøs degree level LL.M. from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

NET/SLET/SET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in University/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Desirable: Research papers published in law journals.

All posts carry admissible allowances as per Central Government rules applicable to the ILI employees.

Age limit: - Professor upto 55 years, Associate Professor upto 50 years, Assistant Professor upto 45 years as on last date of submission of application.

The age of superannuation for the members of faculty shall be 65 years subject to opinion of a Screening Committee that such faculty members to be of continued utility to the Institute and such screening is to be done before attaining the age of 62 years as per the existing Service Bye-Laws of the Institute.

An advance copy of the application along with requisite fee should reach the institute office by stipulated date. Application received late shall not be entertained and delay in transit shall be the responsibility of applicant.
- 4. Fulfilment of condition of minimum qualification shall not necessarily entitle any applicant to be considered for appointment and no reasons for rejection shall be communicated.
- 5. Institute reserve the right to short-list applicants in any manner as may be considered appropriate with the approval of the competent authority.
- 6. Institute reserves the right of not filling any post without assigning any reason.
- 7. Full name may be mentioned in application form. If there was change of name at any stage of time, original name may also be mentioned.
