Pay Scale

The Pay Scale is as per the University of Delhi/ University Grants Commission norms. Assistant Professors are recruited in the Pay Band-III of Rs. 15,600-39,100 with Academic Grade Pay Rs. 6000 plus usual allowances as admissible from time to time.

Essential Qualifications for the posts of Assistant Professor

- 1. The eligibility criteria and qualifications are as per the University of Delhi/ University Grants Commission norms.
- 2. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST /Persons with Disability viz. physically and visually disabled or those who passed their Master's degree prior to 19-09-1991 and hold a Ph.D degree) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.
- 3. Candidates must have qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC (state level eligibility test SLET/SET).
- 4. Candidates who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for awards of M. Phil/ Ph.D. degree), Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- 5. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Master's Degree Programme in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.

General Note:

- 1. The candidates applying under PwD category must specifically mention in application, the main category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC for the purpose of computing the reservation.
- 2. The candidates applying under PwD category are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No. 36035/3/2004-Estt (Res) dated 29.12.2005. The format is available at the website www.persmin.nic.in.
- 3. Male candidates may also apply.
- 4. Separate applications must be submitted for each post.
- 5. In case of the applicant has appeared for the NET examination and the result is awaited at the time of submission of the application, the applicant must inform the result as and when it is declared failing which it will be presumed that the applicant has not qualified the same and is ineligible for the post of assistant Professor.
- 6. In case the applicant has submitted thesis for award of Ph.D. or M.Phil. and the result is awaited at the time of submission of the application, the applicant must inform about the award of the Ph.D. as and when the result is declared.
- 7. The candidates already in service must apply through proper channel.
- 8. The college reserves the right to change the number and nature of posts.
- 9. The college reserves the right not to fill up any or all the post(s) advertised.
- 10. On the recommendation of the Screening Committee, the college reserves the right to call any eligible candidate for interview even if he/she may not have applied for the post within the stipulated time.
