ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ADMISSION FOR THE SESSION 2014 - 2015

Applications are invited for admission to the following courses offered by the Regional Institute of Education (RIE), Bhubaneswar for the session 2014–2015 in ONLINE/OFFLINE modes. Please visit the RIE-Bhubaneswar website www.riebbs.ac.in for details. Candidates seeking admission should have passed the qualifying examinations from a recognized Board/Council/University. The courses are affiliated to Utkal University, Bhubaneswar and recognized by NCTE, New Delhi. The medium of instruction is English for all the courses. <a href="https://www.opening.new.opening.n

In addition to the courses listed below, RIE Bhubaneswar also offers a Four Year Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. course (PCM and CBZ streams). Admission to this course shall be made through a Common Entrance Examination (CEE) to be conducted by the Regional Institute of Education, Ajmer. Please visit the RIE Ajmer website http://www.rieajmer.raj.nic.in or www.rieajmer.ac.in or www.ncert.nic.in for necessary details. After receiving the candidates list from RIE Ajmer, admission to this course of RIE Bhubaneswar will be made following the existing norms of Utkal University to which RIE Bhubaneswar is affiliated.

	<u>COURSE</u>	ELIGIBILITY Note: Candidates passing any other equivalent examinations except those mentioned against each course below will not be eligible.
1.	Four Year Integrated B.A.B.Ed.	Pass in +2 Arts/Science/Commerce stream with minimum 50% marks in aggregate. Candidates who have passed +2 Examination before 2013 will not be considered for admission.
2.	Two Year B.Ed. (Secondary)	Pass in +3 Degree Examination in Arts/Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate. Candidates who have passed +3 Degree Examination before 2010 will not be considered for admission.
	(i) Science Stream a. Phy. Sc. & Mathematics (PM) b. Phy. Sc. & Bio. Sc. (PB)	Pass in +3 Science Examination with any one of the following subject combinations: (a) Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics for PM, and (b) Chemistry, Botany and Zoology for PB, out of which one subject should have been studied for THREE YEARS.
	(ii) Arts Stream	Pass in +3 Arts Examination with at least two school subjects i.e., one from (a) and one from (b) below: (a) English, Hindi, Odia, and Bengali, and (b) History, Geography, Political Science, and Economics, out of which any one subject should have been studied for THREE YEARS.
3.	One Year M.Ed.	Pass in B.Ed. with 55% marks in aggregate or B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. with 55% marks in Education component.
4.	M.Sc. (Life Science) Ed.	Pass in 4 Year Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. with Chemistry, Botany, Zoology (CBZ) as in RIEs of NCERT with 55% marks each in Science and Education components or B.Sc. in CBZ with either Botany or Zoology studied for THREE YEARS with 55% marks in aggregate and B.Ed. with 55% marks from any recognized University.

MODE OF SELECTION

M. Phil. in Education

(a) On the basis of marks secured in the qualifying examination for courses at SI. No. 1 (One) and 2 (Two).

DETERMINATION OF HOME STATE

Admission to M.Sc. (Life Science) Ed. Course is open to candidates from all the States and UTs of India.

Admission to all other courses is limited to candidates from the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal and the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The Home State of candidate seeking admission to the above courses except M.Sc. (Life Science) Ed. will be determined in terms of the location of the Institution from where the applicant passed the qualifying Board/Council/University examination. In case of candidates who have passed from Institutions located outside the States/UTs given above, the home state will be determined on the basis of either (a) the current place of posting on Transfer/Settle down on Retirement on or after 30.06.2013 in the Central Govt./Autonomous Institution/Organization of the applicant's father/mother/spouse, which should be supported by certificate from the Competent Authority mentioning the date of transfer/retirement and complete postal address, or (b) Residential and Nativity Certificate from the competent authority not below the rank of Tahasildar of the respective State/UT.

In case of RIE-Bhubaneswar pass-out students seeking admission to M.Phil. and M.Ed. Courses, the Home State will be determined on the basis of the state from which the candidate was first admitted to the Institute.

For M.Sc. (Life Science) Ed. Course, the Home State will be determined on the basis of Residential and Nativity Certificate from the competent authority as the admission is open to all the States & UTs of India.

RELAXATION:

Relaxation of 5% marks is allowed in qualifying examinations in case of SC/ST candidates. (If any seats reserved for SC and ST categories remain vacant, the first preference will be to fill up the seats by vice-versa and then it will be on merit basis.)

RESERVATION:

Seats are reserved for SC/ST/OBC/Minority and Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates as per mandatory rules.

Note: (i) Candidate claiming reservation under OBC category should produce certificate clearly mentioning Other Backward Caste/Class (OBC) or अन्य पिछडा जाति/वर्ग and not belonging to creamy layer.

- (ii) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC) to be obtained from the competent authority not below the rank of Tahasildar.
- (iii) For Minorities, certificate to be obtained from the competent authority.
- (iv) For PH candidate the percentage of disability should be 40% or above and the certificate should be issued by the competent authority not below the rank of Chief District Medical Officer (CDMO).

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee of `250/- per month shall be charged from every candidate except SC/ST.

Scholarships are awarded to students as per NCERT rules. SCHOLARSHIP:

APPLICATION FEE: Application fee of ` 400/- (` 200/- for SC/ST only) shall be charged for each application (online/offline) for each course and each subject combination.

> For online application the fee has to be deposited through online payment (SB Collect) only.

> For offline application the fee may be deposited either through online payment (SB Collect) or through account payee Demand Draft drawn on State Bank of India or any nationalized bank in Bhubaneswar in favour of "GENERAL FUND ACCOUNT, RIE, BHUBANESWAR" payable at State Bank of India, RCE Campus Branch (Code No. 5302) Bhubaneswar-751022.

HOW TO APPLY: Candidates may apply for all courses at Sl. No. 1 to 5 in either ONLINE or OFFLINE mode following the procedure laid down in the RIE Bhubaneswar website www.riebbs.ac.in. Separate application form along with application fee is required for each course and subject combination.

> Please note that for offline applications the relevant forms are to be downloaded from the RIE Bhubaneswar website mentioned above.

> Filled in offline applications for all courses should be sent to In-Charge, Academic Section, Regional Institute of Education (NCERT), Bhubaneswar - 751022 along with relevant enclosures so as to reach RIE Bhubaneswar not later than 5.30 p.m. of 30.06.2014.

Each **OFFLINE** application form should be sent with the following **enclosures**:

- (a) copy of SB Collect transaction slip or Demand Draft as proof of payment of application fee,
- (b) self-attested photocopies of Certificates and Mark Sheets from H.S.C. onwards and Documents/Certificates for claiming state quota and category, and
- (c) a self-addressed Post Card.

N. B.:

Applications (online as well as offline) which are found to be incomplete/incorrect /illegible/false in any respect and applications received after due date will be summarily rejected without any refund of the fees paid for the same. Candidates withdrawing from courses after admission will have no claim for any refund of the fees deposited by them.
